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ONE WOMAN'S HISTORIC BATTLE AGAINST EMINENT DOMAIN

LITTLE PINK HOUSE

A True Story of Defiance and Courage

It's often been said, "You can't fight city hall."

Don't tell that to Susette Kelo. In 1997 the forty-year-old nurse scraped up enough money to buy her own home, an old cottage in a blue-collar neighborhood overlooking the seacoast in New London, Connecticut. The house needed work, but she didn't care. Susette painted it pink and moved in, believing her dream had come true. She was wrong.

Months later Pfizer, Inc., the world's largest pharmaceutical company, announced plans to build its new global research and development headquarters right next door. The State of Connecticut put up \$100 million to pave the way. The City of New London quickly sought to buy out all the nearby property owners to make way for a five-star hotel and other facilities.

Susette wouldn't budge. Finally, on the day before Thanksgiving, she and her neighbors who had also refused to sell found condemnation papers tacked to their front doors. Through eminent domain, the City of New London was taking their homes.

Susette and her friends had ninety days to vacate.

Desperate to save her house, she rallied her neighbors and waged an eight-year fight against a popular governor, a powerful corporation, and relentless city officials. Her struggle made national headlines and went all the way to the United States Supreme Court, where it brought about the Court's most controversial decision since *Roe v. Wade*. In 2005 the Supreme Court ruled 5-4 in favor of the government's right to seize private property from one citizen and give it to another capable of generating higher tax revenues. But the story of the little pink house didn't end there.
