Current item up for Invitation to bid, (ITB). 3/19/10

King County is seeking a new owner for a 1908 farmhouse located in the Krain area between the cities of Black Diamond and Enumclaw. The Ocepek-Wigton farmhouse will need to be moved to a new location. This effort is being conducted as part of a Memorandum of Agreement between King County Department of Natural Resources and Parks, King County Historic Preservation Program and the Washington State Department of Archeology and Historic Preservation.

If the house is moved to a site in the Krain area (within two miles of the intersection of SE 400th Street and 264th Avenue SE) and keeps its general exterior appearance, it may be eligible for landmark designation and various benefits, including restoration grants, low interest loans and property tax reductions.

Sealed bids will be accepted until 10:30 am May 12, 2010. The minimum bid is \$1.00.

The Buyer will be responsible for coordination and cost of all subsequent actions:

- Acquire or determine a new location for the house;
- Obtain all required permits to relocate the house; and
- Transport the house from the County site;

The Buyer will have approximately 6 months to move the house from the County site.
