- Suspended the Right of Peaceful Assembly.
- Most monumental crisis.
- 1905 - 1945 vs. SCOTUS suspending U.S. Constitution during an emergency.
- Chain of legal decisions approving racist eugenics, e.g. poor women sterilization.
- NY, PN, CA, NV operation church in Caesars Gambling Casio or Gambling in Reno.
- PN Fed Judge struck down lock down.

1st Speaker

- West District of PN - Steel Town
 - 41 year old Trump appointed
 - Full trial
 - Found no evidence at trial
- FBI/CIA study using white lab coats who order torture and over 1/2 people involved in the study complied with the simulated torture.
- Wal-Mart OK while mom and pop shops not OK re. COVID-19 restrictions.
- We have never ever locked down for any reason.
- Theoretical white paper did not make sense under its own rules.
- Nursing home force disaster months unending.
- Sick only.
- Quarantine not statutory met
- No fundamental rights to make a living.
- PN governor way left
- There is indeed a right to make a living and assemble.
- The Constitution cannot accept a new normal.

2nd Speaker

- Examining data sets
 - Should reproduce data out of lab and real world.
 - Media refuse to debate
 - Twitter account blocks him.
 - Public Health has crushed further debate.
 - Most corona victims were infected and recovered without knowing.
 - The model failed in late March and April, 50,000 to 70,000 in hospital and the real number were 15,000.
 - Lock downs failed.
 - Same governors 6 months later still calling for 2nd wave of lockdowns.
 - Public Health went crazy in March and will not listen to facts.
 - Almost no one under 60. 40 - 50% extremely elderly or sick.
 - We have to balance response.
 - Simplest health measures work best, masks near ZERO.
 - Masks signal sick people versus all masked.
 - 80 to 90% Americans do not know anyone who died from COVID-19.
 - New Zealand and Australia lead by progressive extreme lockdowns.
 - Tech Companies like Amazon and Apple benefiting ultra powerful company censoring.
 - 1960 had 230 billion health cases.
 - 2020 had 4 trillion health cases.
 - 1 billion/week cases were COVID testing
 - And Health Care benefitting.
 - These trends are not going away!
 - Fight this!

3rd Speaker - John Henderaker

- COVID is a political event.
- Woodstock was held during Hong Kong Flu with no social distancing.
- Fundamental restrictions e.g. stay home, close business, etc. to flatten the curve.
- Models predicted millions of deaths.
- CDC contributed.
- Federal cash incentives to hospitals paying to max COVID cases.
- How many died by COVID survey found 9% lied or misinformed.
- Over hyping of COVID to cost President Trump 2nd term.
- Churches shut down but not liquor stores and box stores.
- So many exceptions.
- No correlation to shut downs and COVID severity.
- Thousands of little stores shut down.
- Largest big business box stores OK.
- Public employees OK.
- Big business, Public employees, Urban areas, i.e. mostly Democrat OK.
- Republican hurt more than Democrats.
- Security over freedom.

Censorship

- Mining organizations owning whole towns.
- Monopoly whole public square
- Public space is first amendment application.
- Private monopoly of public square, e.g. Twitter, YouTube, Google, FaceBook.
- Courts done -
 - these are private companies,
 - political license to do what they want,
 - no constraints,
 - If they want immunity they must abide by first amendment restrictions.
 - 75% control, e.g. Google and Twitter.
- PCR (Possible COVID Response) were hugely over stated.
 - 38% worse ahead.
 - 38% worse behind.
- Public square shut down is censorship.
