Dear Representative and Senator Manzella:

I. I came across the attached Montana Administrative Register Notice 44-2-250 No 19, dated 10/08/2021, please see attached scan.

- I submitted my comments to the Montana SOS Office 10/16/2021 regarding finding no requirement for U.S. Citizenship verification in the following State ARM's pertaining to Voter Registration Requirements, Provisional Registration, Late Registration Procedures, Voter Identification, and Related Definitions. (See attached ARM and my notes)

- I never heard back from the Montana SOS Office regarding what action was being taken, so I wanted to share this apparent omission with you both.

II. Here is my research notes on the U.S. Constitution regarding c/Citizen and voting.

- Citizen with a capital “C” is mentioned 7 times in the U.S. Constitution, Articles I thru VII.
 - 1) <https://usconstitution.com/documents/the-constitution-of-the-united-states/>
 - 2) However there is no mention of the word “Citizen” or “Citizens” in the Bill of Rights Amendment I thru X.
 - 3) There are 9 matches for “citizens” and 2 matches for “Citizens” in Amendments 11-27. And no match for “Citizen”.

- The U.S. Constitution defines a United States Citizen as follows:
- **AMENDMENT XIV**
 - 1) *Passed by Congress June 13, 1866. Ratified July 9, 1868.*
 - 2) *Note: Article I, section 2, of the Constitution was modified by section 2 of the 14th amendment.*
 - 3) **Section 1.**

All persons born or naturalized in the United States, and subject to the jurisdiction thereof, are citizens of the United States and of the State wherein they reside.
 - 4) **Section 2.**
 - 5) But when the right to vote at any election for the choice of electors for President and Vice-President of the United States, Representatives in Congress, the Executive and Judicial officers of a State, or the members of the Legislature thereof, is denied to any of the male inhabitants of such State, being twenty-one years of age,* and citizens of the United States, or in any way abridged, except for participation in rebellion, or other crime, the basis of representation therein shall be reduced in the proportion which the number of such male citizens shall bear to the whole number of male citizens twenty-one years of age in such State.
- **Amendment XV**
 - 1) The right of citizens of the United States to vote shall not be denied or abridged by the United States or by any State on account of race, color, or previous condition of servitude–
- **AMENDMENT XIX**
 - 1) *Passed by Congress June 4, 1919. Ratified August 18, 1920.*
 - 2) The right of citizens of the United States to vote shall not be denied or abridged by the United States or by any State on account of sex.
 - 3) Congress shall have power to enforce this article by appropriate legislation.
- **AMENDMENT XXIV**
 - 1) *Passed by Congress August 27, 1962. Ratified January 23, 1964.*
 - 2) **Section 1.**

The right of citizens of the United States to vote in any primary or other election for President or Vice President, for electors for President or Vice President, or for Senator or Representative in Congress, shall not be denied or abridged by the United States or any State by reason of failure to pay poll tax or other tax.
- **AMENDMENT XXVI**
- *Passed by Congress March 23, 1971. Ratified July 1, 1971.*
- *Note: Amendment 14, section 2, of the Constitution was modified by section 1 of the 26th amendment.*
- **Section 1.**

The right of citizens of the United States, who are eighteen years of age or older, to vote shall not be denied or abridged by the United States or by any State on account of age.

III. The several states constitutions are subordinate to the U.S. Constitution.

- From this research it is obvious to me that the U.S. Constitution requires that U.S. Citizenship be established to vote for every American.
- Since the state is using many forms of official and not so official ID, e.g. Student ID for authorization to vote,
 - It seems that most forms of official ID do not meet the U.S. Constitution test to prove individual U.S. Citizenship.
 - The only valid official ID showing Citizenship that I can see is a U.S. Passport which shows your place of birth.
 - Even then your place of birth does not validate your distinction as a natural born U.S. Citizen.
 - Nor whether you have been naturalized.
 - Nor whether you have been thrown over the border.
 - Nor a drop baby by an illegal alien.

This loose standard on U.S. Citizenship reflects the state of our no border control and disgraceful elections, see graph below.

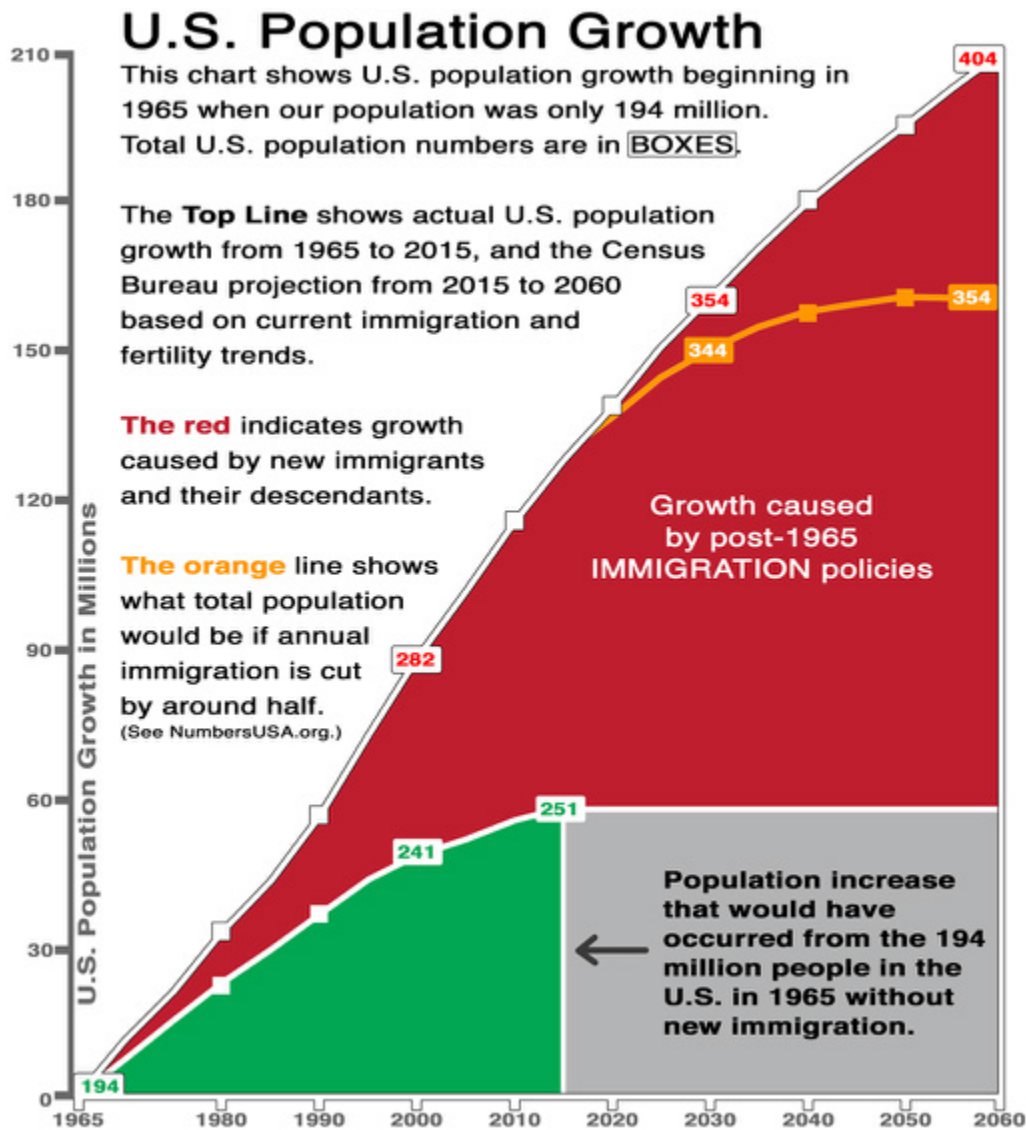


Figure 1 Click on Chart to see Election Fraud in America - A National Disgrace Continually Updated
