But there's a national organization called the "Ballot Initiative Strategy Center" that pushes antiinitiative bills in legislatures throughout the nation. They have a national agenda to shut down the initiative process everywhere possible. But their press releases always portray themselves as nonpartisan. But check out how they describe themselves on their own website:
